What You'll Need:

- A range of loose parts such as ropes, tyres, planks, guttering, camouflage nets etc.
- Connectors such as string, masking tape, Velcro straps or ball bungees.
- A camera!

Useful Tips!

Use the activity to consolidate children's positional vocabulary e.g.

up,
over,
through,
under
behind...and so on

It is a fun way to support pro-social skills such as teamwork, leadership, communication.

It also helps develop problem solving and fine motor skills as children attempt to connect different materials together.
